Allocation of Sports Funding grant at St John's C of E Primary Lemsford April 2016 - March 2017

The government introduced a new funding grant in September 2013 to strengthen opportunities for sport in school.

Details of the amount our school will receive for year 2015/16 and its proposed allocation can be seen below. Funds have been allocated in accordance with the Sports Funding Action Plan.

St John's will continue to use the funds to promote high quality coaching and access to a range of sporting and competitive activities.

How the money will be spent:

- Half of the funding buys into the Welwyn Garden City Sports Partnership which runs inter school activities both competitive and coaching; training and support for staff; training child play leaders to run lunchtime activities.
£4225.00
- Part of our funding provides our weekly football/athletics coach for our Thursday after school club which is open to both girls and boys
£1,100.00 approx
- PE Apprentice from our Sport Partnership is funded 1 day each week to work alongside teaching staff to support pupil's knowledge and skills and she/he will also deliver activities at lunchtimes and after school
£1,200.00

The remaining allocation will be spent on further developing excellence in PE in our school and may include:

- Supporting CPD for staff
- External coaching
- Providing after school sports club
- Paying for training for staff other than through the partnership
- Providing new equipment to enhance provision of PE at St John's
