A massive thank you to all parents and children for their support and help with the school fete.

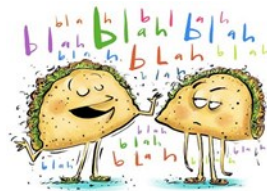
It was a wonderful event and has raised lots of money. The final total is still to be calculated and we will let you all know in due course.
