Reminder that children need to be in school by 8.30am on Tuesday 19th September. We will be leaving at 8.45am at the latest for a prompt 9am start.

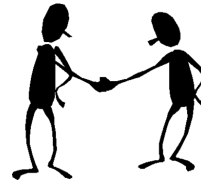
